On the Course with Doyle

Hopefully there will not be an April fools and springtime weather will arrive and stay consistent. Maybe all of that cold is finally behind us and the weather will be more suitable for outside recreation. Thanks to everyone for having patience during the winter months on frost delay mornings and also for avoiding wet areas with carts. One noticeable difference I have seen this year is that there was a dramatic improvement in ball marks being repaired and more divots were filled. Thank you for all your help.

As the warmer weather returns and soil temperatures begin to rise we will become more aggressive with fertility this month. Mainly the greens but also other turf areas that may need the extra push to get going. Many of you have enjoyed the way the greens rolled this winter, and thank-you for the compliments, but we are now at the point that turf grass health has become the number one priority. Mowing heights will be raised slightly throughout the month. This doesn't necessarily mean that the greens will get a lot slower, however there will be a subtle difference in speed as the Bermuda grass starts to grow effecting ball roll. Some of the greens that have an excessive amount of poa annua may be sprayed to eliminate this troublesome weed to avoid any potential transition problems. The overseed will die as well so there may be some temporary discoloration.

Mole crickets have definitely returned in full force. We will continue to spot spray to keep damage to minimum while we are waiting for the peak egg hatch which is when the bulk of the spraying will take place.

PLEASE CALL AHEAD FOR A TEE TIME! You can book a tee time up to one week in advance. Don't assume that just showing up that we will be able to get you out on the course. You can also book your tee time on our website, www.thecountryclubatlakecity.com. Thank you for your cooperation.

Golf cart traffic causes more damage than anything else on a golf course. Please fix the ball marks on the greens, yours and others, and please fill in all the divots with sand. We thank you for your cooperation.

If you receive your statement and newsletter by e-mail and still receive it by mail and don't want to or need to, please let us know so we can stop sending it in the mail. Our goal is to have everyone that has e-mail to receive their statement and newsletter by e-mail only. If you don't have e-mail, no problem. We thank you for your help.
