## On the Course with Doyle

Some decent amounts of rainfall last month kept the mowing equipment quite busy especially the rough mower. The high heat along with adequate soil moisture was all it took to make the Bahia grass grow rapidly. You add the sand being stirred up under each deck and that's enough to completely wear out a set of blades in about two or three weeks. Unfortunately the use of growth regulators on Bahia grass is cost prohibitive. The amount required is about 2 to 3 times the amount needed for Bermuda grass not to mention that it doesn't work at all on weeds so we would have to keep mowing anyway.

One of the most important parts of any golf course maintenance operation is equipment maintenance. Every piece of equipment must be maintained on a preventative type schedule that will hopefully prevent possible part failures at premature times and also extend the machines life and its reliability. The extent of maintenance varies by the machines function on the course as well as the conditions that it operates in. Also there is a significant amount of maintenance involved in keeping the mowing equipment cutting properly, especially the reel type mowers. The role of the Equipment Technician is one of the most important roles in any golf course maintenance operation and can be one that is sometimes overlooked. At our facility we are fortunate to have Mr. Robert Young as our Head Equipment Technician. Mr. Young does an outstanding job maintaining our equipment and is very valuable to us at The Country Club.
