On the Course with Doyle

A rather mild climate in January is hopefully a sign that spring will arrive earlier than expected. Regardless of what mother nature has planned our plan for the golf course in February will be similar to last years plan with a few modifications. First on the list is to clean up any weeds that the fall pre-emergent application did not prevent. Some afternoon closures of nine holes may be necessary to accomplish this due to the herbicides ability to have an adverse effect on overseeded areas. The wind proved to be my enemy last month and only a small amount of spraying took place. Next will be to finish off any tree or plant trimming that may need to be done prior to spring. Next the series of pre-emergent herbicide applications will begin this month with all Bermuda grass areas being targeted for control of unwanted summer weeds such as Crabgrass and Goosegrass. This year our pre-emergent application will be sprayed instead of being spread with fertilizer allowing for more fertility during the peak growing season. Due to a rather mild winter thus far the fairways have held up quite nicely this year allowing the focus of our fertility to be on the holes that will need nutrients the most.

Thanks to everyone for filling divots, repairing ball marks, and for being observant of the cart rules. Every bit of your help contributes to keeping this course a great place to play golf. Thank you and have a great month.

All we need is a credit card number to pay your account balance on the first of each month and an e-mail address for you to receive your statement and newsletter by e-mail only. Then you will receive \$50 credit. Please let us know!

Golf cart traffic causes more damage than anything else on a golf course. Please fix the ball marks on the greens, yours and others, and please fill in all the divots with sand.
