Even with the severe lack of rainfall the fairways have made tremendous progress over the past month with some being almost totally healed. Isolated fertilizer applications will be made throughout the month to finish the healing process.

We have finally reached the point in the year when we must do one of the most important things that we do to the greens that everyone hates to see. That's right it's time to aerate. We will be doing this on June 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> weather permitting of course. In the weeks following the greens aerification we will start aerating fairways with the slicing blade. We had originally intended to do this earlier in the year but due to irrigation issues along with drought conditions we decided it would be safer to wait for better conditions.
