#### The US Open Blitz

The US Open Blitz will be on Saturday, June 18. The entry fee is \$30, which \$12 is for the blitz and \$18 is for carryover skins game. The skins is optional, but you must get in to be eligible for The Beltone Cup. The format is your blitz points added to a pro playing in the third round of the US Open. The left over money in the skins game will be added to The Beltone Cup prize fund. This will be done for The Open and PGA. Points will be awarded based on finish in these events with the winner winning The Beltone Cup and the prize fund.

### Fourth of July Blitz

The Fourth of July Blitz will be on July 4th. The entry fee is \$30, which \$12 is for the blitz and \$18 is for carryover skins game. It is open to anyone and anytime, but you must play with someone else that is playing. Each Hole is worth \$1 from everyone. Wherever the last skin is, you get your money back. Let's say there is 20 people playing and you win the only skin on #10, you would win \$10 from all 20 people (\$200) and then everyone gets \$8 back. Should be a lot of fun, so DON'T MISS OUT!

# On the Course with Doyle

The month of May finally brought some warm enough temperatures to get the Bermuda grass growing more aggressively. The fairways have made tremendous progress over the past month with some being almost totally healed. Another accomplishment last month was by successfully suppressing the mole cricket population therefore deterring those aggravating burrowing animals. I wish that I could say that the mole cricket problem was over but there will still be some issues throughout the Summer which we will continue to address.

We have finally reached the point in the year when we must do one of the most important things that we do to the greens that everyone hates to see. That's right it's time to aerate. We will be doing this on June 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> weather permitting of course. The same week on Friday June 10<sup>th</sup> there will be a tree root pruning service working on the course. Some of fairways and even some greens have a significant problem due to the large amounts of oak or pine tree roots. These roots are depriving the turf of water and nutrients and some of the thin areas can be corrected through this process. A good example of the damage tree roots can do to turf is the right side of 9 greens. I have actually hit a root that my cup cutter would not cut through while changing cups. Thank you and have a great month.

The pool is open and please remember that the pool is for our members only. If you have a single membership you are the only one that is allowed to use the pool. If you have a family membership your dependent kids and grandkids are allowed to swim with you. If you know someone that is not a member and might want to obtain a pool membership, the cost is \$550 plus tax for the season. Everyone must check in before they use the pool. Please be patient with us as we want to make sure that everyone using the pool is a member. If you have any questions or concerns, please give me a call. Thank you.

When you are playing golf, if possible pair up with someone on the cart. If we see two people riding by themselves, you will be asked to pair up or pay for the extra cart. The cart warranty is based on the hours a cart is used, the more carts go out, the quicker the warranty expires. Also, more carts mean more golf cart traffic, which means more damage. We need all the help that we can get in this matter. Thank you.

Always remember to make a tee time if you plan on playing golf. Don't assume because you play every Thursday at 8:45, that you will be able to play. So help us out and remember to book that tee time. Always remember to start on hole #1, groups of more than 4 need to be approved and please let faster groups play through.

Please help Doyle out by KEEPING THE CARTS OFF THE FAIRWAYS as much as possible! Please keep the carts off the green and tee slopes as much as possible. Golf cart traffic causes more damage than anything else on a golf course. Please fix the ball marks on the greens, yours and others, and please fill in all the divots with sand. This is a very important time for the golf course and we need your help! We thank you for your cooperation.
