On the Course with Doyle

There are small signs of spring all around. Birds are starting to make their departure home, some of the trees are beginning to bloom, and the warm season turf grass is about to begin its journey to recovery. Spring green-up of turf grass is not necessarily dependent on outside air temperature alone. Even if temperatures are reaching 70 or above the grass may still be slow to grow or regain its color. This is due partly to the soil temperatures in the root zone being lower than the air temperature by possibly 10 or more degrees depending on location. Once soil temperatures reach the mid 60 range the roots will become more active and the plant will start to show significant signs of improvement. Night time temperatures can impact soil temperature significantly. Typically this temperature change occurs in March or April but can be as late as May or June. Let's all hope for March or April to speed up the recovery process and make a round of golf more enjoyable.

First on the agenda this month is to get the pre-emergent/fertilizer application made. We will be spreading this around the second week of the month. This will help fend off most of those unsightly weeds that we had last summer. Part of the Nitrogen source in this blend has a moderate potential to burn the grass if driven upon following the application therefore we kindly ask everyone to avoid cart traffic in these areas as much as possible. This is meant mainly for fairways and green surrounds however some tee surrounds will be treated as well. These driving practices will also help in our recovery process over the next couple of months.

Finally, I'm sure that everyone has observed that the mole crickets have become active again. We will be spot spraying to keep populations down until our main treatment is made in May. Thank you for all of your patience and cooperation.
