On the Course with Doyle

The end of February proved to be a good indicator that spring will arrive early. Let's hope for an extended spring so that many rounds of golf can be enjoyed before that miserable summer heat arrives. In Florida you just never know what may happen such as last year when it seemed like spring was shortened again. It's almost as if we had another full month of summer. These changes in our typical climate can force changes in our agronomic plan. Changes such as herbicide or insecticide applications that tend to be moving to earlier times in the year to maintain adequate pest control. Weed seeds are germinating earlier and of course the dreaded mole crickets are becoming active sooner. Since the majority of our mole cricket battle will not begin until May there may be isolated treatments made to control this pest on areas where the populations are too high or where their damage is resulting in adverse playing conditions.

Since we have made the leap into the spring months, a problem that can arise is the potential for a poor transition on areas of excessive cart traffic. Please find alternate routes to drive carts especially around tees and greens and maybe even exit a cart path prior to reaching its end. Your help along with us modifying our maintenance traffic will hopefully give these areas an improved chance for recovery. Thanks to everyone for all of the help and support. Have a wonderful month.
