On the Course with Doyle

The season of Spring is here and hopefully we have seen the last of good ole Jack Frost. Unfortunately a significant amount of blooming plant material suffered due to sub freezing temperatures last month. We did finally get some needed rain at the end of the month, well a little more than what was needed but who's complaining. This unfortunately delayed the pre-emergent/fertilizer application which ended up being a blessing in disguise. If the material would have been applied when scheduled we would have watched it all wash away. We will reschedule for the first part of March and hope for better weather conditions.

Most of you have noticed the newer irrigation controllers that were installed over the past two months. This has proven to be a extremely valuable upgrade to the course. These controllers offer more scheduling options as well as precise irrigation run times. We will be able to use less water and save electricity due to the extent of these controllers capabilities. It will now be rare to see the irrigation system running during the day unless we are performing maintenance, watering after a fertilizer or pesticide application or irrigating during drought conditions. Most of the controllers are set up to start watering at the tee box and end just short of the green. The reason that I mention this is that the response time for one station to shut off and the next one to start is considerably faster than before and I wouldn't want to wet anyone.
