On the Course with Doyle

The last week of April proved to be very trying for the overseed. The higher temperatures forced the decline of some Ryegrass especially in poorly irrigated areas. Transition time is here and we are going to become very aggressive with the Bermuda grass. All throughout the Winter and Fall the greens were kept on a lean foliar diet. Now granular and liquid fertilizer applications will be made to promote more aggressive growth in preparation for the summer months. This combined with good cultural practices such as aerating and verticutting will hopefully minimize this years transition period. We have decided to wait until June 1st to aerate the greens. This way the Bermuda grass will be a little more aggressive thus shortening the healing process.

The fairways, green slopes, and tees will be pushed a little harder as well. The Nitrogen source that will be used has a high potential to burn the turf until watered in properly. For this reason and many others that have a negative impact on turf health please drive carts on paths and in the rough as much as possible over the next couple of months.

I'm sure that most have noticed that some ropes were removed from some of the tee areas. This will decrease part of our maintenance throughout the summer and it also looks more attractive without them. Please keep carts off of these areas so that there will never be a need for them again. They were installed initially to regain turf coverage that was severely declining due to excessive cart traffic. Thank you for your cooperation.

We need your help! Please drive the carts using the 90 Degree Rule. More importantly please keep the carts off the green slopes as much as possible. Golf cart traffic causes more damage than anything else on a golf course. Please fix the ball marks on the greens, yours and others, and please fill in all the divots with sand. We thank you for your cooperation.

If you receive your statement and newsletter by e-mail and still receive it by mail and don't want to or need to, please let us know so we can stop sending it in the mail. Our goal is to have everyone that has e-mail to receive their statement and newsletter by e-mail only. If you don't have e-mail, no problem. We thank you for your help.
