On the Course with Doyle

The final days of April proved to be very trying for the overseed. The higher temperatures forced the decline of some Ryegrass especially in areas where there is a lack of adequate irrigation coverage. Transition time is here and we are going to become more aggressive with the Bermuda grass. All throughout the Winter and Fall the greens were kept on a lean foliar diet. Now granular and liquid fertilizer applications will be introduced to promote more aggressive growth in preparation for the summer months. This combined with good cultural practices such as aerating and verticutting will hopefully minimize this years transition period. The greens are scheduled to be aerated on the 5th and 6th of this month.

The fairways, green slopes, and tees will be pushed a little harder as well, mainly the areas that tend to decline during the winter months. The Nitrogen source that will be used has a high potential to burn the turf until watered in properly. Signs (no carts on fairway) may be posted on the fairways when an application has been made and these will not be the holes where the signs would typically be seen so please avoid traffic on these fairways when a sign is posted. The fairways will be aerated this month using a slicing blade. This procedure will be done to all fairways and some fairways that transition poorly may be sliced on more than one occasion.

We appreciate all of your cooperation last month when we had a very wet golf course. There were no tire tracks or ruts left behind (with the exception of #8 rough which could not be helped). Outstanding!
