The first few weeks of October did not feel like Fall weather at all, and then we spread the seed on greens and the climate abruptly changed. The cooler/cold temperatures have proven to be challenging for the seed to germinate in a timely manner but the good news is that the forecast for early November will bring some much improved germination temperatures and we can get the greens cut soon.

The seed germination is not the only problem with the cooler temperatures last month. The Bermuda grass has drastically reduced its growth. This is where it becomes very important to avoid as much stress as possible to the plant. Everyone could contribute by avoiding cart traffic on Bermuda grass areas as much as possible. There were several places where the turf became severely stressed earlier this year due to the irrigation troubles we had and any additional stress would only hinder our spring recovery. On behalf of the entire maintenance staff we hope everyone has a wonderful Thanksgiving.
