# On the Course with Doyle

The recent cooler temperatures sure have been quite enjoyable. We have finally reached the point in the year where that dreadful summer heat is all but a memory. The Bermuda and Bahia grass have slowed drastically and now we are ready to make preparations toward overseeding. This year we have decided to scale back the areas that are seeded, mainly fairways. The reasoning for this is to allow the turf to become considerably stronger in the spring and summer months. We have seeded fairways for many years and sometimes it proves difficult for some areas to heal fully during the summer months. Our plan is to only seed Greens, Tees, and collars. On the par 3's we will seed the approach as well. The greens, collars and approaches will be seeded next month (November 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>). We will begin seeding tees toward the end of this month. Since we are not seeding fairways this year a pre-emergent herbicide will be needed to keep out winter weeds such as poa annua. Other areas such as green and tee slopes will also be treated which may result in some temporary closures early this month. It will be of utmost importance to control cart traffic this winter so that a desirable surface will remain all season so please keep carts in the rough as much as possible from this point forward. Thank you for your cooperation and Happy Halloween.

When you are playing golf, if possible pair up with someone on the cart. If we see two people riding by themselves, you will be asked to pair up or pay for the extra cart. Our warranty is based on the hours a cart is used, the more carts go out, the quicker the warranty expires. Also, more carts mean more golf cart traffic, which means more damage. We need all the help that we can get in this matter. Thank you.

PLEASE CALL AHEAD FOR A TEE TIME! You can book a tee time up to one week in advance. Don't assume that just showing up that we will be able to get you out on the course. You can also book your tee time on our website, [www.thecountryclubatlakecity.com](http://www.thecountryclubatlakecity.com). Thank you for your cooperation.

Have you been a member for at least a year and want a \$50 credit on your account? We have given about 130 members this credit already! All we need is a credit card number to pay your account balance on the first of each month and an e-mail address for you to receive your statement and newsletter by e-mail only. We need your help! Please drive the carts using the 90 Degree Rule. More importantly please keep the carts off the green slopes as much as possible. Golf cart traffic causes more damage than anything else on a golf course. Please fix the ball marks on the greens, yours and others, and please fill in all the divots with sand. We thank you for your cooperation.
