The growth regulator had to be applied cautiously to the greens unfortunately making the speed inconsistent at times. The high heat mixed with some wet conditions along the way made for more than ideal conditions for disease development over the past month. Mix in some localized dry spots and it has become a true juggling act. We are trying to become more proactive so that we keep disease under control and also get more growth regulators out to hopefully increase green speed before The Rountree.

This month we will continue normal maintenance as well as make preparations for the upcoming Rountree tournament. Also this month we will begin preparations for overseeding which is right around the corner. The main goal will be to start the pre-emergent weed control program to keep out the unwanted Poa Annua and other fall and winter weeds. We will also begin to raise mowing heights slightly mainly on slopes and fairways. Good luck in the tournament and have a great month.

Golf cart traffic causes more damage than anything else on a golf course. Please fix the ball marks on the greens, yours and others, and please fill in all the divots with sand. If you receive your statement and newsletter by e-mail and still receive it by mail and don't want to or need to, please let us know so we can stop sending it in the mail. Our goal is to have everyone that has e-mail to receive their statement and newsletter by e-mail only. If you don't have e-mail, no problem. We thank you for your help.
