On the Course with Doyle

We have finally made it over the hump of summer. I am sure looking forward to some cooler temperatures. The high heat mixed with some wet conditions along the way made for more than ideal conditions for disease development over the past couple of months. The greens were the main issue over the summer making it difficult to stay on a good growth regulator schedule. They had leaf spot issues as well as brown patch issues causing us to apply additional fungicides therefore having to decrease the frequency and the rates of plant growth regulators. Mix in some localized dry spots and it has become a true juggling act. We are trying to become more proactive so that we keep disease under control and get more growth regulators out to hopefully increase green speed before The Rountree. Another problem that was encountered last month is the presence of higher numbers in the mole cricket population. We had several different hatch periods this year. Mix that with this pests ability to develop somewhat of a resistance to certain pesticides and we are left with many of these pests wreaking havoc on the course. We have begun to retreat areas where the mole crickets are at unacceptable levels. We will continue to treat until we have them back under control.

This month we will continue normal maintenance as well as make preparations for the upcoming Rountree tournament. Good luck in the tournament and have a great month.
