Now we have reached the point in the Summer season that the mowing equipment is doing its best to keep up with the aggressively growing grass. intended weekly mowing schedule is as follows: Greens mowed daily, Our Collars and Approaches twice a week, Tees twice a week, Fairways twice a week, Bermuda grass rough twice a week, and Bahia rough once a week. When you add in the other daily duties such as bunker raking, changing cups, string trimming, there is little time left to focus on other projects that need attention. Another hurdle we must overcome is equipment failure. Even the best or newest machines are not exempt from this problem. Our equipment is operating in high temperatures and not to mention this is not the smoothest of golf courses which really creates a problem with bearings on our reel mowers. The rough is the worst area of the course. No irrigation leads to dusty conditions which gives the mower a good sandblasting daily and destroys a set of blades in no time. When you add these factors with aged equipment it turns into quite the challenge during the summer months, therefore I am pleased to announce that Mr. Travis Green is now our Equipment Technician as well as Assistant Golf Course Superintendent. Travis has many years in the golf industry and is a very welcome addition to our staff.
