As Winter is now a distant memory and Spring has begun, we are starting to see many improvements in turfgrass vigor all course. The pre-emergent/fertilizer throughout the was successfully applied last month resulting in a nice green up. The cool mornings still have the soil temperatures a little on the low side for the Bermuda grass which will continue to suppress growth. The fertilizer that was used will continue to feed the turf for the next month and half therefore the turf will continue to soil temperatures continue to rise. Our next improve as pre-emergent application will be made in May and continue our efforts to rid the course of Goosegrass.

The mole cricket battle is far from over but we have successfully reduced the number and we will continue to hold them off and hopefully lower the amount of eggs that can be laid. Our plan at this point is to use a pesticide in May that works well on newly hatched mole crickets therefore reducing the numbers even further. Thank you and have a great month.

We need your help. We are allowed to have two players per cart once again. We know everyone has enjoyed being able to ride in a cart by yourself, but we will require everyone to ride with someone. Unfortunately, the golf course does not like it. Golf carts do more damage to the course than anything else. If you elect to ride by yourself, you will have to pay the single rider surcharge of \$5. If we see you riding by yourself when you could have rode with someone else, we will charge you the single rider fee of \$5 on your account. We need to reduce the amount of carts on the course, for gas usage and wear on the carts and the course as well. Thank you for your help, understanding and cooperation.
