I hope that the groundhog does not see its shadow this year. We had some warmer temperatures toward the end of last month which resulted in some green Bermuda grass around the course and if this trend continues, we will be in an advantageous position going into the spring. I have personally seen many years that the cold weather has severely damaged the turf resulting in poor playing conditions as well as extended transition periods. The decision to not overseed fairways over the past years has also had a positive impact on turf health. That along with keeping Poa Annua out of the fairways has given us the head start needed to provide the turf with no competition in the spring allowing the turf to recover faster and to build a healthier root system to aid in surviving the extremes of summer.

Our mission to keep the course Poa Annua free has proven to be quite the challenge. This nuisance weed has developed somewhat of a resistance to certain herbicides and forced us to look for alternatives or increase the rates of herbicides that are being used presently which could possibly prolong the transition phase in the spring. We will be spraying some areas again this month so please be prepared for some parts of the course to be closed temporarily. Thank you and Happy Valentine's Day.
