# On the Course with Doyle

Higher temperatures and an extreme lack of rainfall resulted in difficult growing conditions last month. Since our irrigation system is only a single row design the edges of several fairways suffered significantly as well as some of the green and tee surrounds. Our second fertilizer/pre-emergent application was made toward the end of the month which has resulted in a nice green up in adequately irrigated areas.

On the 7th and 8th of this month we will be aerating greens. We only plan on doing 9 holes each day however we may try to do more the first day due to the overall green size being smaller on the front nine.

During adverse weather conditions like we had last month please keep carts out of these stressed areas as much as possible and please use the 90 degree rule. Thank you for your help with this during these tough times.

# Straight from Carl's Desk

We will be hosting the Gainesville Junior Tour on Monday, June 28th. This will affect tee times in the morning. So make sure you contact the pro shop for tee time availability that morning. And as always, it is strongly recommended to make a tee time before coming out to play, just because you play every Thursday at 10:00 does not mean that you will be able to play at that time.

We need your help. We are allowed to have two players per cart once again. We know everyone has enjoyed being able to ride in a cart by yourself, but we will require everyone to ride with someone. Unfortunately, the golf course does not like it. Golf carts do more damage to the course than anything else. **If you elect to ride by yourself, you will have to pay the single rider surcharge of \$5. If we see you riding by yourself when you could have rode with someone else, we will charge you the single rider fee of \$5 on your account.** We need to reduce the amount of carts on the course, for gas usage and wear on the carts and the course as well. Thank you for your help, understanding and cooperation.

Please help Doyle out by KEEPING THE CARTS OFF THE FAIRWAYS & GREEN SLOPES as much as possible! Golf cart traffic causes more damage than anything else on a golf course. This is a very important time for the golf course and we need your help! We thank you for your cooperation.

When buying something from the pro shop on your account or Carl Bucks, please make sure the pro shop attendant records it properly. It is real hard for them to remember who it was that made the purchase and what it was they bought. Thank you in advance.
