On the Course with Doyle

We have arrived at the point in the year when we begin to take the appropriate steps to ready the course for the trials of summer. First on the agenda is to apply a pre-emergent herbicide to fend off summer weeds such as the dreaded Goosegrass which is the worst in my opinion. Next as temperatures rise mole crickets become more active. We will make isolated treatments to keep the adult populations to a minimum. Keeping the adult population down will drastically reduce the populations that can be seen during the peak egg hatch which typically occurs in May. It would be nice to think that these pests could be controlled completely with one application however that is just not the case so we will continue the battle throughout the summer until the ones that remain tunnel down for the winter. Finally, we will become a little more aggressive with fertility on the greens. We will be introducing small/frequent foliar treatments to slowly supplement the Bermuda grass as it begins to wake up with the main goal being a gradual transition that won't adversely affect green speeds. As the warmer weather becomes more frequent the two grasses will be competing for space so there will be some slow down in speed which is unfortunately unavoidable. Thank you and I hope with the arrival of some good weather we will see more of you out there enjoying the golf course.

We have no outings scheduled for March. However, it is strongly encouraged to make a tee time before coming out to play, just because you play every Thursday at 10:00 does not mean that you will be able to play at that time. We apologize in advance for any inconvenience this might cause you.

We need your help. We are allowed to have two players per cart once again. We know everyone has enjoyed being able to ride in a cart by yourself, but we will require everyone to ride with someone. Unfortunately, the golf course does not like it. Golf carts do more damage to the course than anything else. **If you elect to ride by yourself, you will have to pay the single rider surcharge of \$5. If we see you riding by yourself when you could have rode with someone else, we will charge you the single rider fee of \$5 on your account.** We need to reduce the amount of carts on the course, for gas usage and wear on the carts and the course as well. Thank you for your help, understanding and cooperation.

Please help Doyle out by **KEEPING THE CARTS OFF THE FAIRWAYS & GREEN SLOPES** as much as possible! Golf cart traffic causes more damage than anything else on a golf course. This is a very important time for the golf course and we need your help! We thank you for your cooperation.
