# On the Course with Doyle

Now that temperatures are remaining warmer on the average, we will begin to push the Bermuda grass a little harder. First, we will begin to substantially increase fertility on select fairways to promote aggressive lateral growth to achieve more adequate turf coverage. These fairways are always difficult to recover until consistent warm temperatures arrive. On holes 1, 2, 9, 11, 12, 13 and 14 please avoid driving in the fairways as much as possible to aid in turf recovery. Second, the second Pre-emergent/Fertilizer application will made to tees, fairways, and green surrounds. Some of the weeds that we are trying to control are already present due to some plants surviving the cold temperatures and some are just problem areas that have high quantities of seed. Next, we will be treating for mole crickets when we reach peak egg hatch. We will monitor all areas and spraying will begin immediately after the hatch. Finally, we will be aerating greens on May 31st and June 1st. There is a possibility that we may aerate some greens or at least parts of greens that are having problems. Dry areas on greens become difficult to control this time of year and aerating will help alleviate these problems. The positive of waiting until this time of year is that the aeration holes will heal rather quickly. Thank you for your help and support.

We need your help. We are allowed to have two players per cart once again. We know everyone has enjoyed being able to ride in a cart by yourself, but we will require everyone to ride with someone. Unfortunately, the golf course does not like it. Golf carts do more damage to the course than anything else. If you elect to ride by yourself, you will have to pay the single rider surcharge of \$5. If we see you riding by yourself when you could have rode with someone else, we will charge you the single rider fee of \$5 on your account. We need to reduce the amount of carts on the course, for gas usage and wear on the carts and the course as well. Thank you for your help, understanding and cooperation.

Please help Doyle out by KEEPING THE CARTS OFF THE FAIRWAYS & GREEN SLOPES as much as possible! Golf cart traffic causes more damage than anything else on a golf course. This is a very important time for the golf course and we need your help! We thank you for your cooperation.
