On the Course with Doyle

Transition time is finally here and we are going to become very aggressive with the Bermuda grass. All throughout the Winter and Spring the greens were kept on a lean foliar diet so now granular and liquid fertilizer applications will be made to promote more aggressive growth in preparation for the summer months.

The fairways, green slopes, and tees will be pushed a little harder as well. The Nitrogen source that will be used has a high potential to burn the turf until watered in properly. For this reason and many others that have a negative impact on turf health please drive carts on paths and in the rough as much as possible over the next couple of months. The fairways will be aerated this month using a slicing blade. This procedure will be done to all fairways and some fairways that transition poorly may be sliced on more than one occasion. We have already aerated some of the approaches with plans to repeat this process sometime this month. The greens are not scheduled to be aerated this month however if the climate proves to be too harsh on the remaining overseed then we may reschedule toward the end of this month. We have already increased the frequency that we hand water greens to make sure no Bermuda grass is lost during transition.

Finally, I'm sure that many have noticed to green marking poles around the course. These will be placed in many high traffic areas in an effort to disperse traffic elsewhere allowing the turf a chance to recover. In one week I observed that these areas had improved and will continue as long as everyone avoids these areas. Thank for your cooperation with this.
