The time for the fall transformation of the golf course has finally arrived. The cooler temperatures have slowed turf growth significantly over the past couple of weeks. The turf has also taken on a more fall appearance by losing some its dark green characteristics signaling us that it is ready to rest for the winter. With that being said its now time for seed. This year we will be seeding greens on the 5th and 6th weather permitting. High winds or potential thunderstorms could possibly change these dates but we will be optimistic that we can remain on schedule. We will also be seeding collars and some approaches with the same seed that is being used on greens which should provide better playability as apposed to last year. Following greens and collars we will overseed tees. We will only use enough seed for color instead of playability which will allow an easier transition in the spring. Some of the tee locations may be moved around more this winter to avoid excessive wear on tee tops. Please be assured that this is not being done to increase the difficulty of certain holes but rather to give smaller tee boxes relief from excessive traffic. Finally, we appreciate your cooperation with driving habits. It has really made a difference especially areas where the green posts are located.
