I prefer a warmer climate for seed germination but not at the risk of seedling death due to high temperatures. We may opt to wait until the first week of November to overseed greens. Preparations for overseeding such as pre-emergent applications will still take place this month. As always please continue with ideal cart driving habits for the health of the turf.
