As Winter is now a distant memory and Spring has begun we are starting to see many improvements in turfgrass vigor all throughout the course. The pre-emergent/fertilizer was successfully applied last month resulting in a slight green up. The cool mornings still have the soil temperatures a little on the low side for the Bermuda grass which will continue to suppress growth. The fertilizer that was used will continue to feed the turf for the next month and half therefore the turf will continue to improve as soil temperatures continue to rise. Our next pre-emergent application will be made in May and continue our efforts to rid the course of Goosegrass.

This month our main goal is to continue to correct any irrigation issues so that every part is functioning correctly before the extreme Summer heat arrives. Last month as the temperatures climbed areas of poor coverage or malfunctioning sprinklers were noticed especially in overseeded areas and these issues will be addressed first with some corrected already. With that being said, we will be irrigating longer in the morning hours so that we can correct these issues and I apologize for any inconvenience this may cause. Thank you and have a great month.
