On the Course with Doyle

I wish that I could be writing this reporting how well the overseed turned out on greens so far but that is just not the case. The cooler weather immediately following seeding resulted in poor germination for the first two weeks and then a significant amount of rainfall in a rather short period of time caused some seed to wash off resulting in less than ideal seed coverage. These events may sound detrimental to our overseeding goal but they are not. Our main goal in overseeding greens is for visual appearance. Fortunately, this year there were only a few problem areas on greens that needed to be corrected with additional seed and there are many greens that would be fine without overseeding at all. Our plan is to start regular mowing this month and incorporating green sprayable pigments into our fertility program which will provide a more uniform appearance. The tees actually turned out well except those that are poorly irrigated which will eventually obtain coverage with a little help from rainfall.

We would like to express our sincere gratitude to each and everyone for supporting the club throughout the year.
