On the Course with Doyle

Some very needed improvements to the weather finally arrived last month. The cooler temperatures and some very much needed rainfall finally gave the turf some stress relief. With the turf being at a slowed growth state it now is imperative to avoid as many undue stresses as possible. Cart traffic control being probably the most important therefore we kindly ask for everyone to avoid driving in fairways and on green/tee surrounds. Please use available cart paths as much as possible and for holes without paths please use the 90 degree rule. These efforts will help spare the turf from any unnecessary damage which will provide a better playable surface throughout the fall/winter months.

On the 4th and 5th we will be overseeding greens with only temporary closings. During the germination process we will be watering as frequently as possible to maintain adequate seed moisture without interfering with play. The majority will be at night and early morning with some brief syringing throughout the daytime hours. We will also be overseeding tees and collars this year and irrigation practices will be the same as mentioned above. Thank you and have a great Thanksgiving.
