On the Course with Doyle

At this point last month I was consumed with the thought that a severe storm was inevitable, however little did I know that the complete opposite would occur and we would have an entire month without rainfall. The month proved to be challenging but we managed to irrigate enough to keep the turf reasonably healthy with the exception of poorly irrigated areas. Until we receive some significant rain it is extremely important to avoid cart traffic in these locations to avoid additional damage that could potentially be visible throughout the winter. Your cooperation is vital at this point and thank you in advance.

As overseeding is scheduled for November 4th and 5th we will begin by spraying pre-emergent at the beginning of this month. We will also begin to increase mowing heights of non-overseeded areas such as fairways and green and tee surrounds.

Finally, since the rule change that now allows the flag to remain in place while putting I have noticed an increase in wear around the hole locations, particularly the immediate cup edge. Please be careful to remove the ball without dragging hands across the edge and for those with larger hands please remove the flag prior to retrieving the ball. Thank you and Happy Halloween.
